FORMAT:

SIGN IN: From 12.30pm

SCRUTINEERING: 1pm to 4pm

PRACTICE: 4.30pm

Each car will be given a 30 second practice burnout to begin the event.

QUALIFYING: 5.30pm

Two rounds of competition will be conducted with each car having 60 seconds for each judged run.

The top seven cars after the two judged burnouts will proceed to the 10 car shootout final. The final three positions will be taken up by the next best 4 cylinder, best 6 cylinder and best 8 cylinder cars.

TOP 10 SHOOTOUT FINAL: 10pm

The top ten cars will then compete in the Top 10 Shootout Final.

The final will be judged as a single burnout (qualifying runs have no consideration) and the best burnout will win \$10,000*.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- No alcohol or glass to be brought into the Murray Bridge Speedway complex
- Children under 16 not permitted in Pit Area
- No alcohol permitted in the Pit Area
- All persons in the Pit Area must have closed in footwear

BURN OUT REGULATIONS REQUIREMENTS

- All Drivers are to complete Nomination Form and sign the Indemnity Acknowledgement before entering the Pit Area, Any false information on the Entry Form may result in the Driver being banned from future events
- All Drivers must present a current Drivers Licence (Provisional or Full Licence)
- All Drivers and Passengers must wear long sleeved shirts, long trousers and covered footwear , No thongs, sandals, shorts and T shirts allowed , No nylon clothing to be worn We have fire suits that competitors can borrow
- It is mandatory that seat belts are correctly fastened by the Driver and any Passenger during competition
- Helmets must be worn by both the Driver and any Passenger
- No Driver or Passenger is to have any part of their body protruding from the vehicle during competition
- The maximum speed of vehicles within the Murray Bridge Speedway complex and infield is 10 km/hr
- Burn Outs must cease and the vehicle leave the burn out pad immediately on the direction of the Official VEHICLE SAFETY CHECK
- No loose items to be left in vehicle
- All doors must have secure locking mechanism
- Throttle linkages must have effective return spring
- Vehicles should not have any fuel, oil or fluid leaks; radiator overflow bottle is highly recommended
- The fuel tank, if not by original car manufacturer, is to be of a professional construction standard or fuel cell type and securely mounted
- Battery must be securely mounted
- Brakes must be in good working order
- Scatter shields must be fitted to all modified vehicles with manual transmissions
- Front mudguards must be fitted
- Tail shaft loops must be fitted
- Seats must be securely fastened
- From Summernats 31, all burnout participants will be required to wear a fire suit.
- Seat belts must be mounted securely
- Wheel nuts must be fitted to all studs, with no wheel trims to be fitted
- All wheel weights must be either removed from the drive wheels or securely taped
- The intention is to provide as much smoke as possible, without hesitation, in the allocated time limit of 60 seconds
- Headlights must be on
- Any Driver failing to keep within the defined area will be automatically disqualified
- If a tyre or engine blows vehicle is to stop immediately
- Burnouts on pit roads or any other area (other than the designated burnout area) will result in the Driver and vehicle removed from Murray Bridge Speedway Complex and banned from competing in future events The cost of any damage will be charged to the Driver
- Drivers must not consume alcohol for a minimum of 12 hours prior to or during the event (Random Breath Testing Will Occur)
- No alcohol or glass is to be brought into the Murray Bridge Speedway Complex
- Drivers must follow the requests of Officials
